FDOT I-75 at Pine Ridge Road Interchange Improvements

CONSTRUCTION PROJECT
The interchange improvements include the design of a Diamond Interchange (DI), which will significantly reduce delay on Pine Ridge Road, and reduce the number of conflict points to improve overall safety. As a result, the DI also offers the ability to accommodate future traffic volume growth. This project has been designated as a part the Moving Florida Forward infrastructure initiative.

Improvements include:

- Reconstruction of the Pine Ridge Road Interchange converting to a Diamond Interchange Design
- Reconstruction of the interchange on and off ramps
- Construct pedestrian and bicycle accommodations through the interchange
- Install new signals at the ramps
- Resurface Pine Ridge Road through the project area
