#### COLLIER MPO'S LRTP ON TRACK **DECEMBER 2025 ADOPTION**

Collier MPO's 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) is currently being developed with consultant, Jacobs Engineering. Upcoming activities include Summary Reports on Socioeconomic Data, Forecasted Revenues, and a System Needs Plan by Mode. Watch for opportunities to comment via on-line surveys, an Interactive Map, and at public meetings! The target adoption date for the 2050 LRTP is December 11, 2025.

#### MOVE OVER, FLORIDA!

Florida law requires you to Move Over a lane when you

can safely do so — for stopped law enforcement, emergency, sanitation, utility service vehicles, tow trucks or wreckers, maintenance or construction vehicles with displaying warning lights, and any disabled vehicle on the side of the road. If you can't move over - or when on a two-lane road — slow to a speed that is 20 mph less than the posted speed limit. Read more on the FLHSMV webpage.
