#### OPERATION SOUTHERN SLOW DOWN SPEED ENFORCEMENT INITIATIVE 2024

FDOT, in collaboration with the Florida Highway Patrol and local law enforcement agencies, has announced <u>Operation Southern Slow Down</u>, a joint effort with



the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and southeastern states of Alabama, Georgia, South Carolina, and Tennessee. State and local law enforcement agencies in all 5 states will be conducting a week-long speed enforcement awareness campaign July 15-20 aimed at saving lives and preventing reckless driving and speeding, by targeting speeding and aggressive drivers on our roadways.




## FDOT'S FREIGHT & MOBILITY TRADE PLAN

The Florida Department of Transportation is providing an opportunity for the public to review and provide comment on The Freight Mobility and Trade Plan

FDOT Secretary, Jared Perdue, elaborates on the topic in a dynamic 3-minute <u>video</u>, about planning for economic growth through its strategic priorities, by setting policy, elevating programs, and cultivating partnerships.

### COLLIER COUNTY TRAFFIC OPERATIONS ON THE USE OF SIGNALIZED PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

Take a couple minutes to watch a video by Collier County Traffic Operations on the use of signalized pedestrian crossings-it shows how they work and how to use them safely, by pressing the button to activate the signals which will then stop traffic and allow pedestrians to walk on the crosswalks. Collier County has about 220 intersections with pedestrian signals and crosswalks and 6 signalized pedestrian crossing facilities at midblock. These crossings can include Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHB) or Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB) as shown in the two displays below by FDOT's Safe Mobility for Life Coalition:
